BOSTON, MA – Beginning November 27, 2021, Fountain Street Gallery will feature its first Annex Fellows—residents of the City of Boston selected through a competitive juried process—Siena Hancock, Catherine Siller and Katherine Wildman. Their three-person show, “Figment Fragment,” examines social and cultural attitudes towards the body and the self. Through acts of dismantling, disassembling and questioning, the artists embark on a search for new paths to explore both gender and identity overall.

Siena Hancock is a multidisciplinary, non-binary artist who strives to create works which question capitalist structures, the gender binary, and the effect technology has on social customs. They received their BFA from Mass College of Art and Design.

Catherine Siller is a multimedia artist and choreographer whose work affirms queerness and transness and invites us to rethink gender norms and expectations. She holds an MFA in Digital

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Media from Rhode Island School of Design (RISD) and a BA in Visual Arts from Harvard University.

Katherine Wildman's sculptures are personal reflections on gendered expectations, and also desire and sexuality and the complicated moments in which they overlap. She received her MFA from School of the Museum of Fine Arts at Tufts University and BFA in Painting from Mass College of Art and Design.

Juror David Guerra is an independent curator, lecturer, and owner/founder of Á R E A, a multi-format and interdisciplinary gallery that organizes exhibitions and projects. Á R E A features the work of local and international artists and designers. Guerra welcomes creatives of diverse social and cultural backgrounds. His passion for innovation in the arts has led him to collaborate on a variety of projects and exhibitions as a curator in Boston. As a photographer, Guerra has exhibited in galleries in Boston, Provincetown, Providence, and Paris. He studied at University of Havana, Oxford and Harvard University. He also holds a degree in International Relations from Higher Institute of International Relations in Havana, Cuba, where he worked as a diplomat.
