### **Molly Dee**

Dee was born and raised in the Boston area where she was a student at Joseph P. Keefe Technical High School before attending Boston University's School of Visual Arts. There she earned a Bachelors of Fine Art with a double major in Graphic Design & Sculpture and a minor in History of Art & Architecture. She is currently a visual arts teacher as well as an artist.

### **Gerry Menz**

For nearly two decades, Gerry Menz owned and operated Artwear, the award-winning women's boutique in Arlington, MA. She also developed her own line of clothing which was sold in stores throughout New England. Earlier in her life she worked as a costume designer and preschool and kindergarten teacher. Her studio is in her home near Boston, where she lives with her husband, their daughter, and three dogs. Menz received a BA in Art from Emmanuel College.

### **Amanda Millis**

Amanda Millis received her MFA from Massachusetts College of Art and Design and a BA from Smith College. Her work has been recognized in exhibitions throughout the US and Australia and is in private collections worldwide. Amanda lived in Sydney, Australia from 2012-17 where she was a finalist in major art competitions. Millis has been awarded residencies at PLAYA, the Hambidge Center for the Creative Arts, Monson Arts, Virginia Center for the Creative Arts, the Eastern Frontier Educational Foundation,
